RTE's Ryan Tubridy says non-vaccinated people should be 'disinvited' from weddings

'They don't want somebody coming along with the mark of Cain going 'I don't believe in the vaccine' - well then get out, and you're not invited and you're disinvited'

RTE star Ryan Tubridy has shared that he supports the idea of leaving unvaccinated people off the wedding guest list.

The veteran radio presenter chatted to his RTE Radio One listeners Friday morning about an emerging trend in the US where wedding guests are being asked to provide evidence of their vaccine status to attend the nuptials.

While invitations used to host footnotes asking guests to leave their kids at home or make charitable donations, some couples are planning on leaving unvaccinated friends or family members off the guest list, or hoping to set up mobile antigen testing sites the day before their weddings to provide a pandemic-free environment for the event.






Ryan Tubridy enjoys the sunshine near his home in County Dublin

"They're politely worded notes telling guests 'you must be vaccinated' or 'you have to get a COVID test' or both," he explained to viewers.

"According to wedding planners over in the states, they're saying this is the new etiquette now. Couples are not shy about asking guests about their vaccination status."

Typical wedding protocol involves bringing a gift and not wearing white, but now guests must consider their COVID health status too.

"This is what they're saying, because obviously they don't want to have a super spreader event, and they don't want somebody coming along with the mark of Cain going 'I don't believe in the vaccine' - well then get out, and you're not invited and you're disinvited because you're a greater risk to everyone else" Ryan said.



"They have to do it, and there are so few people who are against the vaccination thing now really, that it would be unusual to get a no, but in the states is 50/50 nearly."

The presenter mulled over the fact that the pandemic will have certainly caused family fall out due to the differing beliefs people can hold about the virus.

"I would imagine it causes great friction and arguments so I really wouldn't fancy having that problem."

9. Another RTE presenter Joe Duffy got egg on his face after he slated Irish footballer Callum Robinson for not getting the jab.

Robinson did his talking on the pitch by scoring 5 goals in the next 2 matches




10. RTE's role of shame didn't end there though. J ournalist Joe O Shea appeared on the Claire Byrne show speaking of the unvaccinated

14. Maybe RTE should get their own house in order first before they start lecturing others when their own presenters and guests are involved in the very thing they claim they want to stamp out.



What changed?








16. Pat Kenny from Newstalk who has been stoking fear for 18 months also got his orders to create division in a letter he read out called
